# WHY WATERPROOF A SURFACE?

The main benefit of waterproofing is preventing water from penetrating your surface and causing damage—but it does much more than that. Here are some other benefits your clients will appreciate:

- EASY TO CLEAN. Since the waterproofing layer makes your surface non-porous, it's easier to clean than a surface that has not been waterproofed.
- STAIN RESISTANT. It's non-porous, so when things like chlorinated water, oil, or other contaminants spill onto the surface, it's less likely to stain.

• MOLD AND MILDEW RESISTANT. In places where water collects, having waterproofing protection works wonders to prevent the growth of mold and mildew.

### AN OVERVIEW OF THE PROCESS

Here's what to expect when you hire a contractor to waterproof a floor or outdoor surface.

- SURFACE PREP. Your contractor will make sure the surface is ready so that the waterproofing material will adhere properly. This is done by sanding and thoroughly cleaning the surface, removing all debris. This step is quite labor intensive because it's critical that it's done correctly.
- REPAIR. If the existing surface isn't brand new, the contractor you're working with will need to fix any damage such as cracking, spalling, chipping, etc. Addressing these issues will

ensure that the surface is fully waterproof.

- PRIME. The contractor will apply a primer that will prepare the surface for the waterproof coating.
- APPLICATION OF WATERPROOF MEMBRANE. After prepping and priming, it's time to apply the waterproof coating. Your contractor should take care to make sure the coating is applied evenly and according to the product instructions.
- ADDITION OF DECORATIVE FIN-ISH. At this point SUNDEK can apply another material that will allow you to add texture, pattern and color. This is optional.
- APPLICATION OF SEALER. After the waterproof coating and decorative finish have dried for the appropriate amount of time, your contractor will put the final coat on—a sealer that will further protect the surface.
